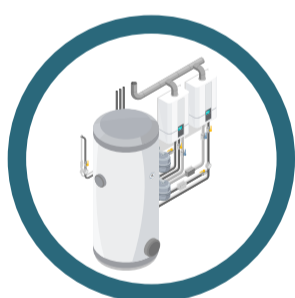
LEARN THE DON'T-DRAIN LIST
